1. Nominations open on 6 September 2017 and must reach the Returning Officer at her office or postal address, **not later than** 12:00 noon (AEST) on Wednesday 27 September 2017. Nominations cannot be withdrawn after this time.
2. Prospective candidates and nominators should verify their financial status and any other qualifications required by the Organisation's rules prior to lodging nominations.
3. A group of eligible members may run as a team for National Officers in accordance with rule 3.7. Each candidate must complete a nomination form for the office they seek. Each candidates should indicate the Team name on this form where provided. A team must submit a Team proposal form. A team must include a member for each National Officer position for which nominations have been called.
4. Candidates for offices which constitute the Governing Council are entitled to have a statement of up to 250 words distributed with the ballot paper. Statements must comply with the Rules and be submitted to the Returning Officer no later than 12:00 noon (AEDT) on 11 October 2017. Statements should be submitted as a Word document by email to nswelections@aec.gov.au.
